

Dr. Burcu Aydın graduated with honors from Bilkent University in 2003, and earned her M.A. and Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Southern California in 2005 and 2007.

She began her career at the IMF in Washington, D.C. (2006–2011), where she worked on policies improving macro-financial stability, and received three awards for her outstanding performance.

Between 2012 and 2018, she served as the Chief Economic Advisor to the Minister of Treasury and Finance, and as the Director of Revenue Policies in Türkiye. In this role, she contributed to the Medium-Term Economic Programs, central government budgets, fiscal policy design, and international financial relations. She also served as a Board Member of Sumer Holding and Vakıf Investment.

From 2019 to 2022, she lectured and conducted research in public finance at Bilkent University.

Since 2023, she has been a Center Director at the Economic Policy Research Foundation of Turkey (TEPAV).

Her work has been published in academic papers, books, and opinion columns. She is a commentator on Bloomberg HT and Ekotürk, and writes for the Turkish Economics Newspaper.

Dr. Aydın is also the founder of Hurra Education, an edu-tech company focused on innovative language learning solutions, and serves on the boards of several private companies.

She is actively engaged in civil society. She is a member of the Board of Trustees of TAGEV, serves on the High Advisory Board of INTES, and is a member of TOBB Women Entrepreneurs Board, ANGIKAD, SSRN, and alumni networks of USC and Bilkent.
